What: Pinelopi Goldberg, Professor of Economics at Princeton University to participate at the 24th Annual Congress of the European Economic Association and 64th European Meeting of the Econometric Society (EEA-ESEM 09). This joint meeting gathers together 1800 experts from around the world and it is organized by Barcelona Graduate School of Economics ([GSE](#)).

Goldberg will deliver the Marshall Lecture entitled "Intellectual Property Rights Protection in developing countries: the case for pharmaceuticals". In her presentation Dr. Goldberg will try to answer the question: is there a case for harmonization of patent policies across countries at different stages of development?
